# INCREDIBLE NAADAM FESTIVAL AND SOUTH, CENTRAL IMPRESSIONS

## DAY 2 | TSAGAAN SUVRAGA (WHITE STUPA) MIDDLE GOBI

Continue your journey to the breathtaking Tsagaan Suvarga, a natural limestone masterpiece sculpted by wind and time. Marvel at the towering cliffs, streaked with colors of white, pink, yellow, and orange. Walk along the ridge for panoramic views and explore the ancient seabed layers exposed by erosion. Sunset here is unforgettable as the cliffs ignite in warm golden tones. Overnight in a ger camp.



## DAY 1. ULAANBAATAR

Arrive at Chinggis Khaan International Airport, where your guide greets you and escorts you to your hotel. Depending on your arrival time, you may enjoy a short orientation walk around Sukhbaatar Square, visit Gandan Monastery, or simply rest after your journey. Accommodation: Hotel.



## DAY 3 | YOL VALLEY (EAGLE VALEY/SOUTH GOBI

Enter the dramatic landscapes of Gobi Gurvan Saikhan National Park. Reach Yol Valley, a deep gorge carved by ancient glaciers. Take a scenic hike through the canyon, where you may encounter Lammergeier vultures, Argali wild sheep and Ibex on rocky cliffs. Admire the unexpected greenery and mountain streams hidden within the desert mountains. Overnight in a ger camp near Yol Valley.

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## DAY 4-5 | KHONGOR SAND

### DUNES/SOUTH GOBI

Drive to the magnificent Khongor Sand Dunes, stretching more than 180 km across the Gobi Desert. Visit a nomadic camel herder family and learn about traditional desert life. Enjoy an optional camel ride along the dunes and experience the silence and vastness of the desert.

Climb the highest dune at sunset to enjoy panoramic views and hear the famous “singing sands.”

Overnight in a ger camp.

## DAY 6 | BAYANZAG (FLAMING CLIFFS) / SOUTH GOBI

After breakfast, drive to the legendary Bayanzag Flaming Cliffs, one of the most iconic landscapes of the Gobi Desert. Known for their fiery red-orange hue, the cliffs glow brilliantly at sunrise and sunset a sight that captures the spirit of the desert.

Dinner and overnight in ger camp near Bayanzag.



## DAY 7 | ONGI MONASTERY

Travel to Ongiin Monastery, a peaceful and historically rich site located along the riverbank.

Explore the ruins of what was once one of Mongolia’s largest monasteries, destroyed during the political purges of the 1930s.

Visit the small museum, enjoy the serene landscape, and relax after several days of travel.

Overnight in a ger camp.



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### DAY 9 | HUSTAI NATIONAL PARK

Depart from Kharkhorin after breakfast and begin your journey toward Hustai National Park, home to the world's last remaining wild horse—the Takhi (Przewalski's horse). Upon arrival in Hustai National Park, visit the small information center to learn about the reintroduction program and the conservation efforts that brought the Takhi back from extinction in the wild.

Overnight in a ger camp



### DAY 8 | KHARKHORUM

Continue to Kharkhorin, the 13th-century capital of the Mongol Empire founded by Ogedei Khan. Visit Erdene Zuu Monastery, Mongolia's oldest surviving monastery, surrounded by 108 white stupas. Explore the Kharkhorin Museum to learn about the powerful empire, trade routes, and ancient culture.

Overnight in a ger camp in Kharkhorin.



### DAY 10 | OPENING CEREMONY

After breakfast, transfer to Central Stadium in Ulaanbaatar to witness the grand opening ceremony of the Naadam Festival, Mongolia's most celebrated cultural event.

Return to your hotel in the evening, carrying the energy and pride of Mongolia with you.

Overnight in hotel in Ulaanbaatar.

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### DAY 12 | TERELJ NATIONAL PARK

After a breakfast we will drive to Terelj National Park, a stunning area of granite cliffs, alpine meadows, and winding rivers.

Visit the iconic Turtle Rock and the peaceful Ariyabal Meditation Temple, where you can enjoy short hikes or optional horseback riding.

Dinner and overnight in a ger camp in Terelj National Park.

### DAY 11| HORSE RISING

After breakfast, depart for the Naadam horse racing field, located just outside Ulaanbaatar. Unlike modern races, these competitions often cover 20–30 kilometers across natural terrain, testing the endurance and skill of both horse and rider. Taste festival foods while soaking in the living heritage of Mongolia's nomadic culture. Return to Ulaanbaatar in the late afternoon or evening, carrying the unforgettable thrill and spirit of the steppe. Overnight in hotel in Ulaanbaatar.



### DAY 13 | DEPARTURE

After breakfast, enjoy some free time depending on your flight schedule.

Your driver will transfer you to Chinggis Khaan International Airport for your departure.

We will assist with luggage and check-in procedures to ensure a smooth and comfortable end to your journey.

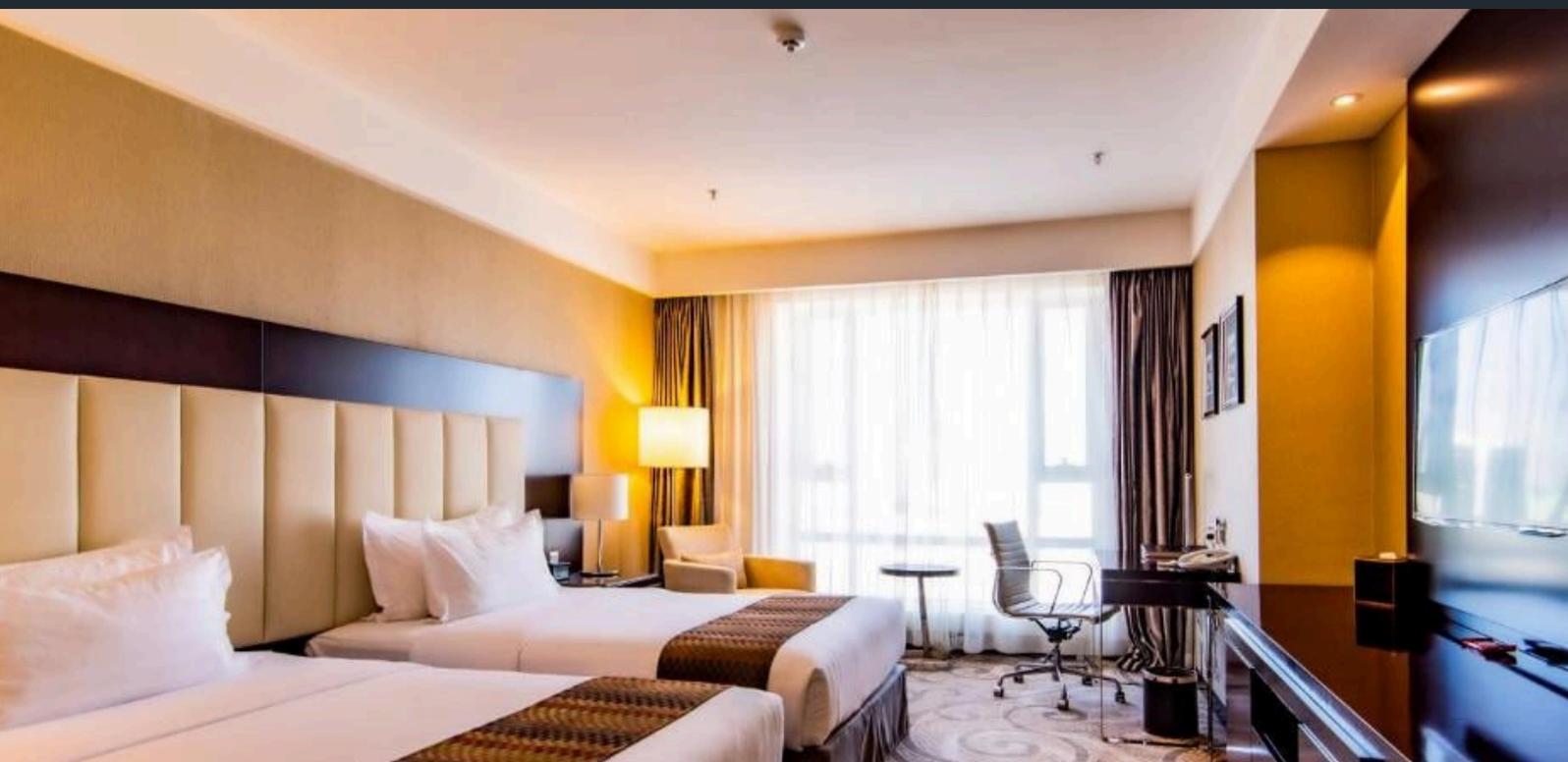
